
RE: Minerals Prospecting Permit

Preliminary prospecting will be accomplished using hand tools and. Small samples will be taken for assay. Core drilling will follow provided initial tests indicate commercial quality material. Operational plan for core drilling will will be submitted for approval prior to any drilling. The upper reaches of Slide creek is within the area of exploration, however, it shall not be affected. Initial sampling will not be noticeable. Existing roads will provide access for core drill; Drill sites will be located on or adjacent to these roads when possible. We anticipate three (3) to five (5) holes should be sufficient to determine the extent of the deposit. No timber removal should be required during exploration.

Reclamation: Drill holes will be plugged and drill sites and access roads will be restored to acceptable conditions.


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

VICINITY MAP


TABLE MOUNTAIN
