DISTRICT: Is 9 miles northwest from shipping point, Sumpter, on the Sumpter Valley Railway. Located about 1905 by J. L. Hazelwood and consists of 4 lode claims and mill site, recorded in Baker county. Located in a high mountain area; country rock is argillite; hanging wall of diorite, and granite footwall; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 10 feet, length 3000 feet. Mineral is gold, also silver, assays at \$6. Water is scarce; power is available from the Eastern Oregon Light & Power Company, nearby. Mine is being prospected by the owner. It has 300 feet of tunnels, and 300 feet of shafts. Owner is Bert Piper, Baker, Oregon.
