DISTRICT: Is 5-1/2 miles northwest from shipping point, Sumpter, on the Sunpter Valley Railway. Located 30 years ago and consists of 11 unpatented lode claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in a high mountain area; the country rock is argillite and granite; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 18 feet, length 4500 feet. Mineral is gold, also silver, assayed at \$11. Water is ample; power is available from the Eastern Oregon Light & Power Company, nearby. Mine is now idle. Equipped with one car, track and hand mining tools. Developed with 1450 feet of tunnels and a 240-foot shaft. Owner is Frank Davenport, Baker, Oregon (Prescott 6/1/37).

WAR EAGLE CLAIM: This claim lies on the north side of the creek and it consist of 2 tunnels, shaft, and cross cut. The country rock is argillite, sheared and crossed in all degrees with numerous large and small faults, ~~fractures~~^{cracks} and slips.
