NAME: Duck Creek Placers Unorganized District Baker County

OWNERS: John T. Hendrix, Mrs. J.T. Hendrix, and Frieda Hendrix,
Half Way, Oregon.

LOCATION: 8 miles northwest of Homestead along the entire length of Duck
Creek.....

AREA: 17 unpatented placer claims, totaling 340 acres.

HISTORY: 5 claims located between 1934 and 1938. No production. Handrix
and Frieda Hendrix are 1937 grub stakers, and Hendrix is a 1938
grub staker.

EQUIPMENT: Cabin and sluice boxes.

DEVELOPMENT: None but location and assessment work.

MISCELLANEOUS: Property could be worked from May 1 to December 1 at least.
Water is said to furnish about 150 miners. ✓ Inches at a
minimum water rise have not yet been recorded. A ditch $\frac{1}{4}$
mile long at the lower end of the property gives an 8 ft. fall.

GEOLOGY: Elevation about 4,000 ft. Both gulch (lower) and flat(upper)
operation. Bedrock rotten granite. Gravel in flat less than
1 ft. in diameter. In the gulch a few larger boulders occur
up to 8 or 10 ft. in diameter. Near the bottom the gravel
apparently is finer grading into a cement gravel and talc.
The gravel is from 8 to 14 ft. deep, but the bottom in the
meadow has not been tested. There are no clay layers seen.
Gold is coarse and flat or rounded, lying scattered throughout
the gravel. It is finer near the surface. The gold is $878\frac{1}{2}$
fine. CONFIDENTIAL: Hendrix is dealing with following concern,
Atlas Gold Dredging Corporation, 102 Brockington Court, Grass
Valley, California. (601 W. 5th Street, Los Angeles). Is
asking price of \$20,000.00, and apparently if testing early
next spring is successful this may be one of the few grub
stakers who will repay his 10%. THIS PROPERTY WAS NOT VISITED.
