PEARL MINE

BAISLEY DISTRICT:

Is 14 miles from shipping point, Baker, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. Located by owner in 1886 and consists of one patented claim, recorded in Baker county. Located in a high mountain area; country rock is granite and argillite; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 4 feet and length 1400 feet. Mineral is gold, assayed at \$12. Water is ample; power can be procured from the Eastern Oregon Light & Power Company; timber on claim. Mine is idle, and there is no surface equipment. Developed with 300 feet of tunnels. Owned by Isador Fuchs, Baker, Oregon. (Prescott--6/1/37).
