"The Carroll B. Prospect consists of 10 claims in SE.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 3, T. 10 S., R. 41 E., which are controlled by S. J. Niblack. The developments consist of a shaft, from which at least one drift, which is partly accessible, has been turned and two adits, each several hundred feet long, on other parts of the property. The predominant country rock is greenstone and cherty argillite of the Elkhorn Ridge argillite, with some gabbro. The quartz vein on which most of the work has been done is 1 to 2 feet thick where exposed in the drift near the shaft. In the other two adits nothing was observed but the greenstone country rock."
