Memorandum

It has been reported that there is a large deposit of good quality limestone on the property of Ray Fromm, Port Orford. The deposit is on the south side of Bear Trap Creek approximately three-fourths of a mile east of U. S. Highway 101 in T. 33 S., R. 14 W. Reportedly the deposit can be traced for several hundred feet from the side of a hill down into the creek. It can be reached in the summertime by an old logging road; in the winter months the road is impassable.

Mr. Fromm promised to submit a sample of his limestone for analysis. The deposit has not been visited by representatives of the Department.

G.M.I. Short Paper No. 9 (p. 1) reports another occurrence of limestone in an area about 17 miles north of this locality.
