

Hood River County

"Gold has been found along the Lake Branch of Hood River, about 2 miles below Lost Lake, but not in sufficient quantity to justify development. At the base of the divide, east of the east fork of Hood River, under Lookout Mountain, there is an extensive outcropping of gray porphyry containing white pyrites of iron and strata of talc carrying some gold."
