Dear Ms. Wolverson:

On January 12, 2018, DOGAMI received the Recreation Baseline Report (January 2018), prepared by EM Strategies, for Calico Resources.

Recreation baseline study methodologies were included in the Environmental Baseline Study Work Plans, dated September 22, 2017 and the methodologies were approved by DOGAMI on December 7, 2017.

The Oregon chemical process mining rules for baseline data collection (see OAR 632-037-0055) do not include specific requirements for baseline information on recreation. The collection of stand-alone data on recreation is consistent with federal National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements.

DOGAMI does not take a position, however, on the adequacy or use of the data for purposes of review by federal agencies.
