Dear Ms. Wolverson:

On September 22, 2017, Calico Resources filed revised Environmental Baseline Study Work Plans for the Calico – Grassy Mountain proposed mining project. The work plans included a section on wetlands (see section 3.6).

As understood, the methodology approved by the Technical Review Team for the wetlands baseline data work plan is primarily encompassed in the required filing and procedures stipulated by the Oregon Department of State Lands (DSL), i.e., the wetland delineation report and the requirements described in Oregon Administrative Rules 141-090, including a State jurisdictional response.

DOGAMI has received that response from DSL, dated May 3, 2018, and DSL has agreed that the wetland delineation report was accurate for the purpose of determining jurisdictional wetlands in the project area. Therefore, DOGAMI acknowledges that the approved methodology for wetlands has been followed.
