

TRANSFER OF SURFACE MINING PERMIT
Under ORS 517 and OAR 632

INSTRUCTIONS & REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST:

- Complete all applicable sections of the Transfer Application form (next page).**
- Submit the following to the Department of Geology (at address above):**
 - Completed application form**
 - \$1,750 processing fee**
 - Proof of Land Ownership**
A current report from a licensed title company, referred to as a TRIO, listing packet, or consumer information report, and is typically free of charge. Examples are available upon request.
 - Acknowledge and accept existing reclamation plan**
The new permittee must sign the signature page of the existing reclamation plan on file to confirm they have read and understand what the reclamation plan entails. If land ownership has changed, and is not the same as the new permittee, the new landowner must also sign the existing reclamation plan. You may request a copy of the existing reclamation plan from DOGAMI.
 - Acknowledge and accept existing permit boundary map and/or site plan map**
The new permittee must sign a copy of the existing permit boundary map and/or site plan map. You may request copies of the required maps from DOGAMI.
 - Acknowledge and accept existing permit conditions**
The new permittee must sign a copy of the existing permit conditions. You may request copies of the permit conditions from DOGAMI.
- Be registered to operate a business in Oregon.**
If the transfer applicant is a company, the company name must be registered to conduct business in the state of Oregon (Secretary of State Corporation Division). Company name and address must match business registry.
- Acceptable reclamation bond or alternative security**
Before the transfer is complete, the transfer applicant (new permittee) must submit an acceptable new reclamation bond or alternative security. The Department will determine the amount of the bond or alternative security based on an estimate of the present and predicted reclamation obligations. *After the transfer is complete*, the reclamation security of the current permittee will be released.
- Transfer other site-associated permits, as necessary.**
If the site has an associated DEQ water quality permit, a separate DEQ transfer form and fee must be submitted to DEQ.
