The well was drilled to a total depth of 8414 ft. The 9-7/8" hole was left filled with 67 pcf drilling fluid from 8414 ft. to 5224 ft. The interval 5224 ft. to 4954 ft. was covered with 40 sacks Class G cement containing 3% CaCl<sub>2</sub>. The placement of this plug on August 9, 1973 was witnessed and approved by a representative of the U.S.G.S. The 9-7/8" hole was left filled with 67 pcf drilling fluid from 4954 ft. to 2183 ft. The interval 2183 ft. to 1843 ft. was covered with 273 sacks of Class G cement containing 3% CaCl<sub>2</sub> in two stages. Cement was tagged with the drill pipe at 1950 ft. between stages. Placement of both stages was witnessed and final stage was approved by a representative of the U.S.G.S. on August 10, 1973. The 10-3/4" casing from 1843 ft. to the surface was left filled with 67 pcf drilling fluid. Top of the casing was left exposed to surface but is covered by a hinged lid which is locked in place to permit the State of Oregon to run temperature surveys. The location and waste pits have been covered with topsoil and returned to their original contour to the satisfaction of the B.L.M. personnel in the Vale Office, as of Aug. 31, 1973. The following tubular goods were left in the well, cemented on the outside to the surface.

- 10 ft. 20" O.D. Conductor
- 148 ft. 16" O.D. 65#/ft., ST&C, R-3, H-40 8 Rd. thd. casing.
- 1992 ft. 10-3/4" O.D. 45.5#/ft., ST&C, R-3, 8 Rd. thd. K-55 casing.

Well was abandoned because hydrocarbons in commercial quantities were not discovered.

It is requested that this information be kept confidential until the lease expires or for a period of 2 years from August 31, 1973.


