

HOMCO SIDEWALL CORES

Described by R. M. Grivetti

- #12
7378 3" Volcanic Breccia - green & black crushed igneous fragmen
Now resembles sandy tuff or fine breccia - larger pieces
may have been crushed in coring.
- #13
5935 5" Tuff? - firm to hard dk gray to black dense fragments
in a soft matrix - May be a weathered basalt. Calcite &
siliceous veins present in part of core.
- #14
4830 4" Basalt? - hard, tough, dense, black basalt in a softer
matrix of same color. May be a weathered (decomposed)
basalt or a breccia.
