

Phase 1: State Consolidated Application Process: Application Review

There are 10 key steps to the permitting process. To submit a consolidated application the first 4 steps must be completed:

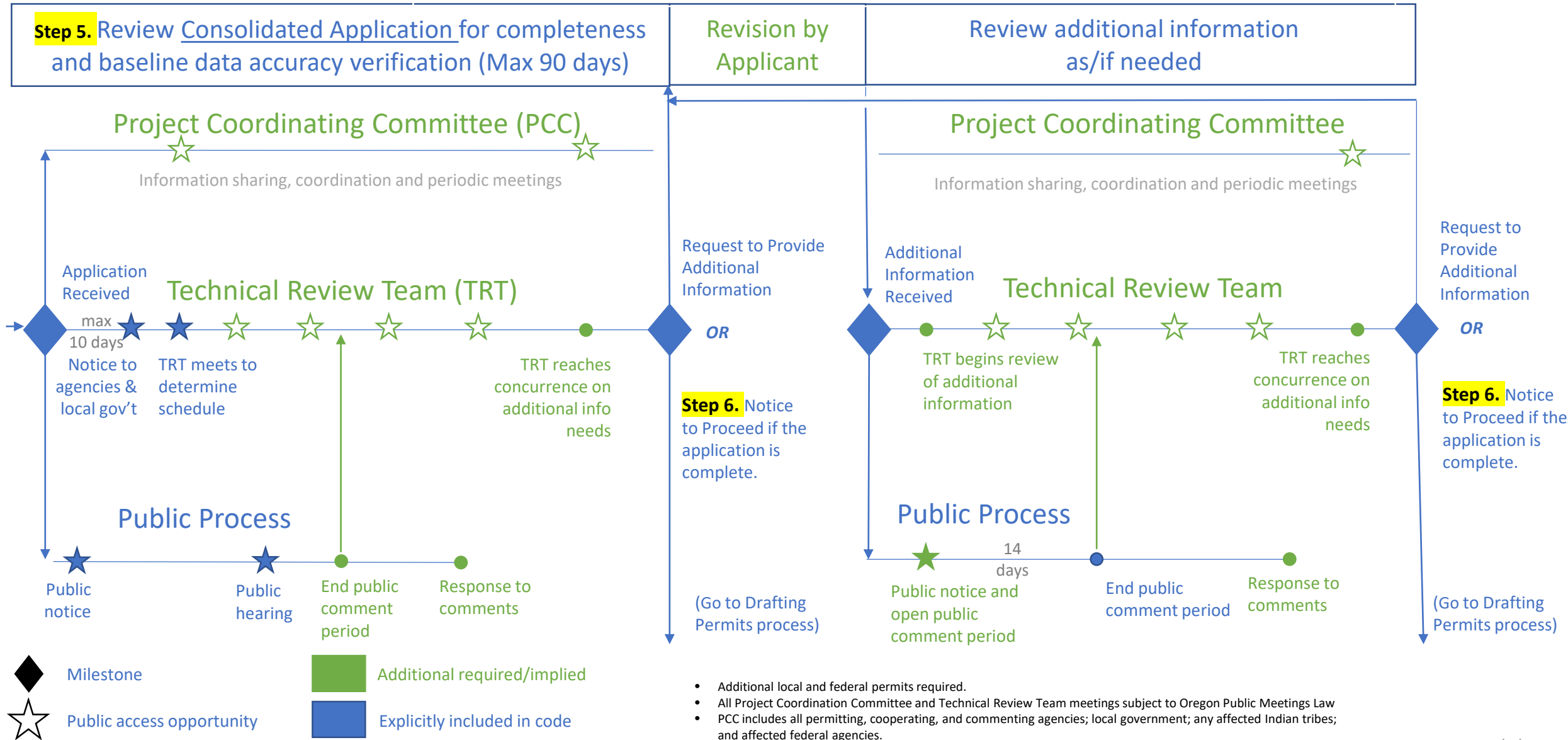
Step 1. Notice of Intent to submit a Consolidated Application.

Step 2. Notice of Applicant's Readiness to Collect Baseline Data.

Step 3. Collection of baseline data.

Step 4. Filing of a [Consolidated Application](#) including: operating plan, baseline data, reclamation & closure plan, alternatives analysis

The review and permitting process for the Consolidated Application includes steps 5-10 as shown in the following flow diagrams.
